**Location: 2nd floor of Landis Valley Museum Store**

After examining images and samples of German & English caps, students will choose from various band & frill styles and hand stitch their own. Shown is one of the styles. All needed techniques will be taught; all are welcome.

Materials fee \$25 - includes cap material (linen or cotton), pre-hemmed frills(ruffles), thread, narrow tape for ties, pattern & instructions, hand-outs.

Bring to class: pins, needles, thread snips, fabric scissors, tape measure, fabric marking pencil. Optional: 2 yards of 1" colored ribbon

**Location: 2nd floor of Landis Valley Museum Store**

Among the various items to add warmth during the changing seasons, simple hoods and over-caps were favorite choices. They were stitched of a single layer of fabric and worn over the day caps as shown in the illustration.

After examining 18th century hood images and samples, students will select their fabric and hand sew a hood or over-cap.

Materials fee \$25.00 - includes fabric, thread, pattern & instructions, hand-outs.

Bring to class: pins, needles, tape measure, thread snips, fabric scissors, fabric marking pencil.
